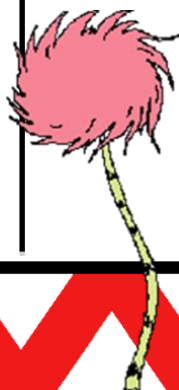
Performing Arts with
