It is essential that each Year Six/Seven student works to the best of his/her ability to achieve an Exhibition of a high standard. Therefore deadlines which have been set for tasks, must be achieved to gain success. Parents are reminded that the Exhibition will be held on **Thursday 25 October, Week Two, Term Four**, from 7pm – 8.15pm. Students will need to be at school at **6.40pm dressed in their black clothes**. Dismantling of displays will take place on the Friday after.

The students will be completing their Reflections during class time in Week Three. Therefore attendance here at school is vital as this is an important part of assessment for their Exhibition.

During the **Exhibition Week (Week Two)** the students will be required to wear their **sports uniform each day**. On Wednesday they will get changed into their black clothes at school to present their Exhibition to the other classes. They will bring their black clothes home on Wednesday, ready for the Exhibition on Thursday night.
