Swimming

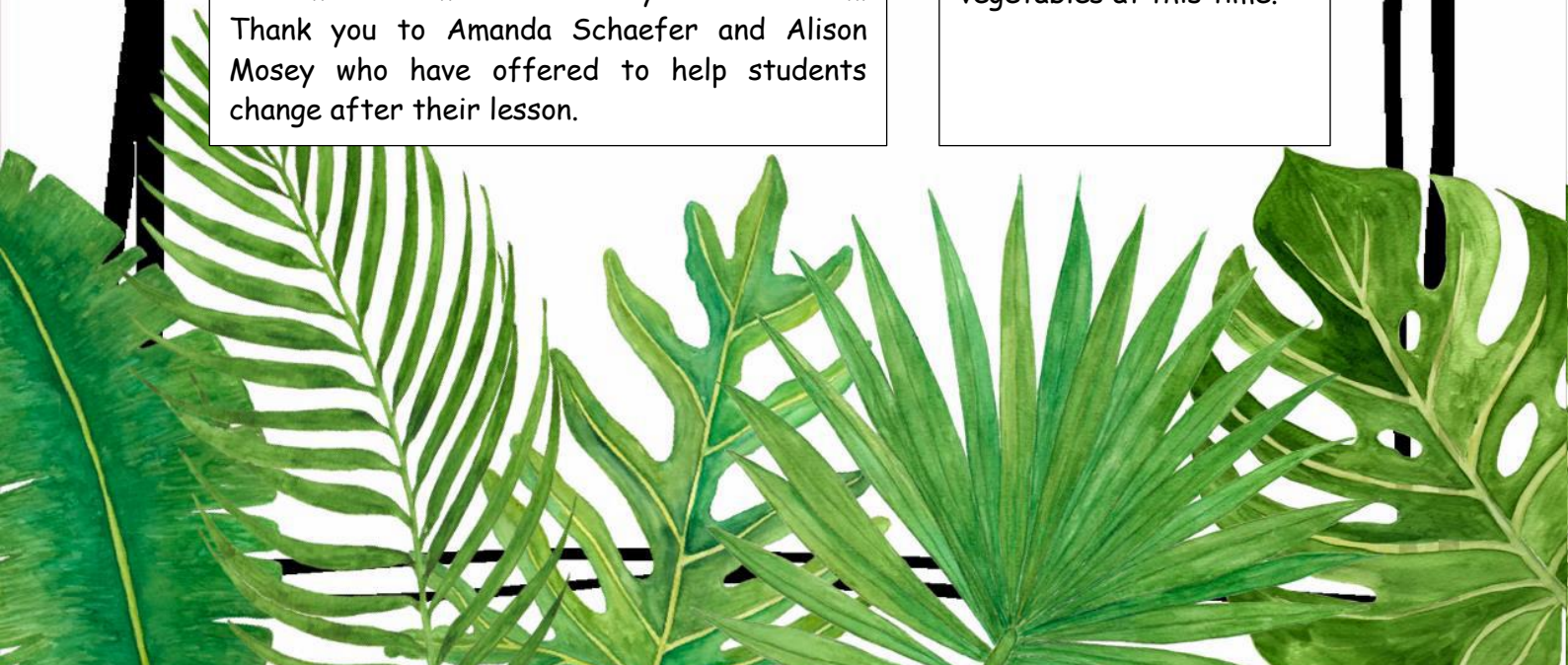
