Literacy

Daily 5 – reading testing – running records

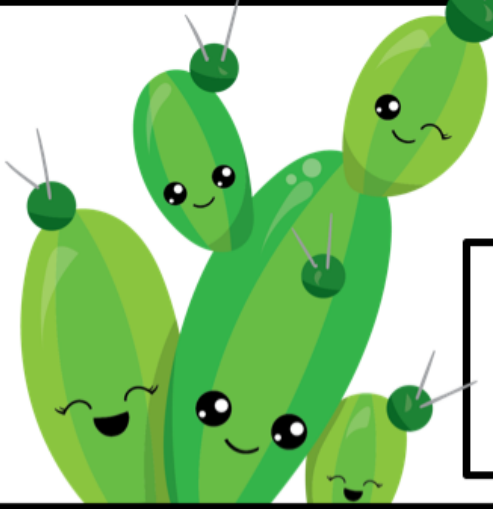
Writing – recount writing about our weekend.
