Writing – recount writing about our weekend. Continuing to investigate procedural texts. The children will write a procedure text about making their tin can lantern.


Mathematics: – Daily Maths rotations.

This unit will begin with a local focus, looking at the places within Eudunda (or your child's local area) and the importance of these places.
