Grammar – past tense verbs

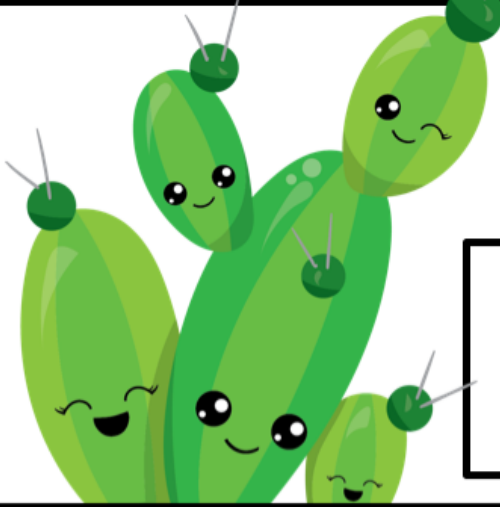
Writing – recount writing about our weekend. Continuing to investigate procedural texts.

Times Tables Challenge

Mr Peters shared at assembly last Friday about a new times table challenge that begins this week. We are inviting all children in our class to become a times table champion. Here is the process

- Choose a times table and learn them: can be 2x, 5x, 10x or 11x
- Choose one set at a time to learn, practise and master
- Negotiate a time to see Mr Peters
- Say them aloud and then be challenged by random problems.
- When you have mastered all of the 2x, 5x, 10x and 11x tables you will receive a Junior times tables certificate and have your photo in the school newsletter.
