Literacy

Grammar – past tense verbs

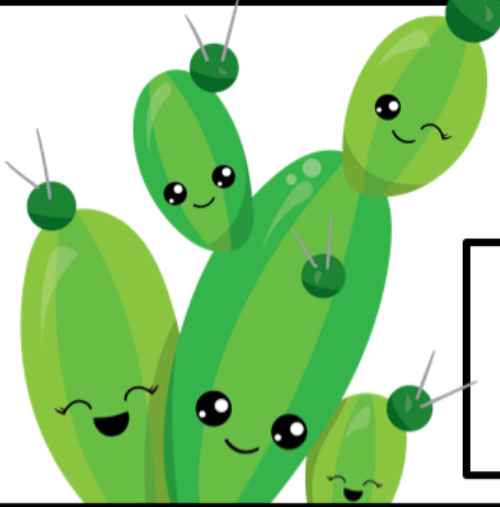
Writing – Continuing to investigate procedural texts recount writing about our weekend..

On Thursday we will also listen to a guest speaker, Mr Des Pfeiffer about how Eudunda has changed over the years.

He will focus on how the buildings have changed as well as the services they provide.

Times Tables Challenge

Mr Peters presented the first times table challenge medal at assembly last Friday. All children are invited to become a times table champion.

Here is the process

- Choose a times table and learn them: can be 2x, 5x, 10x or 11x
- Choose one set at a time to learn, practise and master
- Negotiate a time to see Mr Peters
- Say them aloud and then be challenged by random problems.
- When you have mastered all of the 2x, 5x, 10x and 11x tables you will receive a Junior times tables certificate and have your photo in the school newsletter.

You can support your child at home by assisting them to learn the times table of their choice.
