

St John's Lutheran School is an accredited International Baccalaureate (IB) World School offering the Primary Years Programme (PYP) along with more than 2,000 schools throughout the world. The International Baccalaureate aims to develop inquiring, knowledgeable and caring young people who help to create a better and more peaceful world through intercultural understanding and respect.




Facilities

St John's Lutheran School provides excellent facilities including touch screen, interactive televisions in every classroom, a 1-1 device policy where each student is given access to either an iPad (Foundation to Year 3) or a laptop (Years 4-7). Each classroom has a sound field system installed for optimal learning to occur.

The school grounds include two ovals, double courts, a shaded playground, nature play area and sandpit play areas. Also provided is a sensory room for students with identified sensory needs. The multi-purpose hall area supports learning opportunities such as cooking in the full kitchen, rehearsing and performing on the stage and playing indoor sports.

Enrolment Application

Places in some year levels can be highly sought after so families are encouraged to lodge an Enrolment Application form as early as possible. We have two enrolment intakes for our Foundation class each year. All families are required to have an interview with the principal before the admission of their first child.

Transition to School

A transition program to assist students moving to their new school is arranged which may include a family interview and transition visits as well as relevant information evenings for parents.


Enrolment Policy

St John's Lutheran School offers a Christian Education to all applicants regardless of ethnic origin, religion or disability, provided that:

- 1) Parents seeking enrolment for their child/ children undertake to support willingly and freely the stated purpose of St John's Lutheran School
- 2) Adequate space and resources are available.

Transport to School

St John's has its own school bus which provides a pickup and drop off service to students in the Marrabel/Kapunda regions each day. In addition, bus services to St John's Lutheran School are provided by an arrangement between the school and LinkSA and DECS bus services. A small fee is passed on to parents for these services.
